Dear Friends and Colleagues:

I am happy to bring you information regarding the 2013 New England Band Directors Institute, July 11-13. Each year we try to provide you with an exciting line-up of clinics and forums that will stimulate your musical thinking and encourage you to try new techniques in your teaching. Registration for summer graduate classes begins on April 4.

If you are in a position to attend the institute for credit, you are urged to do so, since our tuition is the principal means by which we are able to make this outstanding institute available to band directors throughout the northeast.

• Option 1 — No credit/ Professional Staff Development Hours only

2. Fill out and return a Graduate Studies Course Registration Form. The course number for 2 credits is ME 5560.01 "Current Trends in Instrumental Music" (2 credits). The Course Reference Number (CRN) is 40037. The cost per credit is \$522 In-State, \$569 Out-of-State. Checks for graduate credit should be made out to Plymouth State University. Course Registration Forms are returned to College of Graduate Studies, 17 High St. MSC 11, Plymouth, NH 03264. If you have completed Step # 1, you may enroll for credit on the first day of the institute. Or, you may register online at www.plymouth.edu/graduate/academics/register/

The difference between ME5120.01 "NEBDI" (1 credit) and ME5560.01 "Current Trends in Instrumental Music" (2 credits) is that those who want to receive 2 credits for their participation in NEBDI will write a brief follow-up paper based on one or more of the topics covered during the institute. The paper is designed to be of direct benefit for your teaching next fall!

• Option 4 — 3 Graduate Credits

Those wanting to receive 3 graduate credits will enroll concurrently in the 2 courses described above, and will submit a longer, more thorough, final paper.

Please plan on bringing your instrument, since some of our sessions will involve playing (not required).

I have also included a list of housing alternatives both on and off campus. Information for on-campus housing is enclosed. You may apply for and pay for on-campus housing online. Our assigned dorm is Langdon Woods, which has private baths and air conditioning. Please note that, if you wish to use on-campus housing, you will need to bring your own towels and bed linens. If you have any difficulty making satisfactory housing arrangements, please do not hesitate to call me. I will be happy to assist you with this, once I know your preferences. You should plan to make your reservations as early as possible.

All participants are invited to attend the NEBDI Banquet held on Friday from 5:30 - 6:45 p.m. Our guest speakers will be Dennis Fisher and Ann Porter. Also, NHBDA will pay tribute to the 2013 recipients of the "Outstanding Band Director" and the "Outstanding Young Band Director" awards. We want for this to be an important event of our conference and a fitting tribute to these music educators. Past banquets have been sold out, so if you would like to be sure to attend, include the banquet cost of \$18.00 along with the conference registration check which you are making out to NHBDA. Any remaining banquet tickets will be available at registration.

Plymouth State University is very easy to locate off of I-93 (Exit 25). Most of our meetings will take place in the Smith Recital Hall on the first floor of Silver Center for the Arts, which faces Main Street in downtown Plymouth.

The Executive Board of NHBDA is very excited about this year's line-up of clinicians and presenters. One of our goals is to feature clinicians who are outstanding music educators and who have a clear understanding of what makes bands work and what helps kids to learn.

The New Hampshire Band Directors Association and the New England Band Directors Institute are about sharing. This institute is an opportunity to develop your ideas and teaching methodologies in a relaxed atmosphere as you listen to others and join in the discussions. We try to address topics that will help us to grow, not only as teachers, but as musicians. Those who have attended in the past have been very enthusiastic about having these pertinent and effective workshops made available to them on our campus for a very reasonable cost. Annually, our institute draws 160 participants from all six New England states—and beyond!

Housing for the Band Directors Institute will be in the Langdon Woods Residential Complex. Langdon Woods offers single and double rooms with private bath and air conditioning. No linens. Full payment is required at the time of reservation. Housing is limited and will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservation requests after July 5 are subject to availability and must be made by contacting Tom Weeks directly at 603-535-3298.

Once your reservation and payment have been received, a confirmation letter outlining your reservation details and information about checking in will be sent to you.

All on-campus housing facilities are non-smoking.

NEBDI – Frequently Asked Questions!

What is the final deadline to register for NEBDI?

Conference registration checks (\$75.00 payable to “NHBDA”) should be received by July 1. Because our ability to accommodate “walk-ins” has been finally tested to the limit, we are asking that the registration form to be received by that date. If you have done so, you may still register for graduate credit on the first day of NEBDI or online, if you wish. Enrollment will be limited to 160 participants.

Do I have to enroll for graduate credit?

No. You may attend by simply paying the conference registration fee (\$75.00 payable to “NHBDA”). However, if you are in a position to attend the institute for credit, you are urged to do so, since tuition is the principal means by which we are able to make this institute available to band directors throughout the northeast.

I have enrolled for credit before. Am I able to do so again?

Absolutely. The course content differs significantly each summer. This will be reflected in the course title of the 2-credit option.

What is the difference between ME 5120.01 “New England Band Directors Institute” and ME 5560.01 “Current Trends in Instrumental Music Education”?

The difference between ME 5120.01 “NEBDI” (1 credit) and ME 5560.01 “Current Trends in Instrumental Music Education” (2 credits) is that those who want to receive 2 credits for their participation in NEBDI may do so by writing a brief follow-up paper based on one or more of the topics covered during the institute. The paper is designed to be of direct benefit for your teaching next fall!

Is it also possible to enroll for 3 credits?

Yes. You may do so by enrolling concurrently in both courses. In addition, your final paper will be longer than is required for 2 credits.

I am looking for recertification hours, not degree credits. Do I fill out the College of Graduate Studies Course Registration Form?

No. You will only need to fill out that form if you are applying for graduate credit.

If I attend the institute for graduate credit, does this mean I have to apply for admission to the Masters in Education degree?

No. Graduate credit may granted independently of study toward the masters degree. PSU does offer an M.Ed. in Instrumental Music Education. If you are interested in pursuing this degree, you may contact the Office of Graduate Studies for details. The M.Ed. in Instrumental Music Education does require 9 NEBDI-related credits.

Should I bring my instrument?

Please do, although it is not required. Sessions involving the Directors Band will be noted on the schedule. In addition, you may need instruments for any of the “hands on” sessions you plan to attend. Space and the number of music folders are sometimes limited. Your cooperation in sharing playing time is always appreciate!

If I enroll directly through the College of Graduate Studies, do I still need to let you know that I plan to attend?

Yes. That way I can be sure that receive any updated information or answer your questions directly. Just contact me at mastickney@plymouth.edu or call me at 603-535-2495.

What about housing?

You will be provided with a list of on-campus and off-campus housing options. Everyone has different preferences on this, so you will need to contact one of those sources on your own. If you stay in on-campus housing, remember to bring your own towels and bed linens, since these will not be provided in the dorm.
