

NHBDA Middle Level Honors Band Audition Requirements 2019

ELIGIBILITY: New Hampshire brass, woodwind, and percussion students currently in grades 6, 7, and 8 are eligible to audition for the NHBDA Middle Level Honors Band. Students must be regularly enrolled members of their school ensemble during the audition and honors performance. Teachers do not need to be members of NHBDA but are required to be present at the Festival should any of their students attend.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS: All eligible students auditioning on wind instruments are required to perform two etudes of contrasting style and three scales. All eligible students auditioning on percussion instruments are required to choose a focus (Mallet, Snare, or Timpani) and perform one etude on their focus instrument and one etude on auxiliary instruments. Students focusing on mallets will submit three scales and students focusing on snare or timpani will submit three rudiments. Each student will submit a total of 5 (five) unbroken and unedited audio files (cuts to audio before and after the student performance are allowed). - MALLET FOCUS:F Major 2 Octaves quarter/eighth; g minor 1 Octave quarter/eighth; chromatic 1 octave in triplets starting on Bb NHBDA Audition Etudes 2019: Mallet and Auxiliary(Available Online)

PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGE IN AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

- Scales have changed to one major, one melodic minor, and one chromatic. They have been universalized as much as possible to allow for whole group instruction. Articulation patterns have changed. Chromatic rhythm patterns have changed.
- Students are required to submit recordings of *two* etudes of contrasting style. A tempo range as well as a stylistic indicator have been included with each.
- <u>PERCUSSION</u> is now asked to choose a focus. Students may audition in more than one focus (please submit a separate application for each focus and upload 5 files per student per focus). The second etude for each focus is a universal auxiliary percussion etude that must be recorded in a single take.

Recordings should consist of student playing only. No commentary. It is understood that applicants will want to use their best take of a scale or etude; however, be aware that splices or edits made *in the middle* of scales or etudes are not accepted and will receive a score of 'zero.' Each student should end up submitting five audio files in total.

- Deadline: Must be **RECEIVED** by 11:59PM on 10/26/18
 Audition Fee: \$8 dollars *per audition*.
- · Med forms DO NOT need to be submitted with student registration and audition material.

Once this email has been received, a folder titled with your school name (e.g. Timberlane Regional Middle School) will be shared with you via Google Drive. It is the Director's responsibility to complete the following:

- Create a folder titled with the student's name and instrument (e.g. John Smith Clarinet)
- Label EACH file with the student's name and audition requirement (e.g. John Smith Etude)
- Supply a PDF scan of the completed registration form titled with the student's name (e.g. John Smith Registration).
